
"Perhaps you already know this title was first used as the name for the Maryknoll Magazine. Today 'The Field Afar' is the name for a set of thirteen videos in which lay people, brothers, sisters and priests tell their stories about living in new cultures away from their native homes. So, if you'd like to experience praying with Buddhist monks in Thailand, rescuing homeless children from the streets of Lima, Peru, helping land mine victims in Cambodia, comforting Aids patients in Nairobi, Kenya, or going to any one of the other scenes features in the videos, go give yourself an evening to view 'The Field Afar.'

'The Field Afar' is more than a documentary series. Viewers join missioners on an adventure – to discover God in other lands and cultures. While remaining true to their own faith, these priests, brothers, sisters and lay missioners walk new paths and form close friendships with people in different countries.

The last episode is about the founders of Maryknoll. In 1911, Maryknoll priests and sisters landed in China and began spreading the gospel. Later some sisters went to Hong Kong and established our Alma Maters, MCS and MSS. Sister Virginia Flagg (formerly Sr. Stella Marie) narrated in this tape. Glad to see her looking so well even though she has had a few minor strokes. Also we see Sr. Helene O'Sullivan, a former MSS teacher, now the Sister President.

These video tapes are inspiring and entertaining. We learn a great deal about people living in the Third World."
