

Obituary

February 17, 1923 - July 28, 1999

Those 'old' Maryknollers who were at MCS in the late '40s and early '50s would surely remember their Chinese teacher, Miss TANG Ching Man, Josephine, Mrs. Shum when she married Shum How-Kin in 1949. She began teaching at MCS after graduating from Northcote Teachers Training College, interrupted only by the Second World War.

In 1955, Mrs. Shum left Maryknoll and joined the public sector, teaching at both the primary and secondary level. In 1977, she retired and spent many happy years with family in Canada and U.S.

Mrs. Shum passed away peacefully in Toronto as a result of a massive heart-attack. She is survived by her husband, 2 sons, 2 daughters, Pauline & Christine, (both of whom are Maryknollers) and 9 grandchildren. To them we offer our sincerest condollences.

February 11, 1925.
