# AAA - Questions and Answers

- ★ **What does AAA stand for?** AAA stands for The Academic Achievement Award.
- ★ **Who qualifies for the award?** The AAA is given to children of members who attain an average of 80% or higher in their six best grade 12 courses.
- ★ **What does the award achieve?** In addition to recognizing the academic achievement of the member's child, the award serves as a means to encourage children of members to attend the association's functions and be part of our Maryknoll community.
- ★ **Are grandchildren of members eligible for the AAA?** No, only children of members are eligible for the AAA.
- ★ **When should a member apply for the award for her child?** As soon as the grade 12 grades are available, the member should mail a copy of her child's official transcript to the postal address of the association. The deadline for mailing in the copy of the transcript is the end of August of the year the child completes grade 12.
- ★ **When are the awards given out?** The AAA is usually presented to the recipient at a function held in the fall. In the past few years the association presented the AAA at the Fall bingo and dinner.
- ★ **Who must be present at the function?** In order to be eligible to receive the award the recipient or one of his or her parents must attend the Fall function.
- ★ **What is required of the recipient at the presentation?** The recipient must produce his or her original transcript at the function and either the recipient or the member will be requested to say a few words about the recipient.
- ★ **What is awarded to the recipient?** The recipient will be presented with an AAA certificate and a small monetary award.
